

Many people who saw them thought, "But they're not even finished!"


Despite this, Turner was appointed professor at the Royal Academy in London and he earned so much money that he was able to build his own gallery. Turner also became a great example for many later artists.






William Turner travelled a lot. Here he painted Paris. What is your favourite city?
